

WVCA QUICK REFERENCE AND TOUR GUIDE

Club Meetings: The membership meeting is the first Thursday of each month at 6:30.

Club meeting place: Capital Auto Group on Mission Street in Salem.

Club Jackets: The current official club jacket is tan. However previous club jackets with club logos are also official jackets. The WVCA emblem is stitched on the back of the jacket. **Contact Kustom Kreations of OR, located at 2710 National Way, Woodburn, 503-981-4046 for the tan jacket and patch.** If you desire, the NWACC shoulder patch may be placed on the left shoulder but is not required. The Club's emblem is only to be worn by WVCA members.

Club attire, name tags, club business cards and car clings: Contact the Treasurer for information on availability and costs.

Points: Member recognition points are:

- One point for attending a sanctioned event
- One point for wearing club attire or name tag at a sanctioned event
- Three points for being a chair or host of a committee or event
- One point for being a working member of a committee or event
- One point for attending each monthly business meeting wearing a name tag.

Points are kept by the secretary and tallied prior to the year-end banquet at which time the top 10% of the club receives recognition for participation and one is selected as member of the year.

Tour Participant Guidelines:

Contact a board member or the tour guide if you have to cancel or want to attend but didn't sign up.

- Fuel your car
- Bring Talk-About radio on club tours (Channel 6 Code 6)
- Arrive a few minutes early at the starting place of the tour.
- Turn on your parking lights during a parade and/or tour.
- Obey all driving regulations.
- Travel will be in the right hand lane except to pass. Change lanes with caution.
- Leave enough room between cars to allow traffic to move through the tour group
- Don't drive reckless
- Always see the car in front of you.
- Always keep track of the car behind you.
- Flash your lights and pull off the road if you have car trouble. Radio the tour leader. Members behind you will assist
- Don't pass other corvette cars on a tour. (Tin cars are welcome but travel in the rear)
- Be safe
